

EVENT PROGRAM



8:30	Students arrive in their classrooms – Teachers to take class roll						
8:45	Teachers take students (with their school bags) to Under Cover Area to line up in their factions. Students will then march onto the oval in their factions and stay in their faction bays for the races. Teaching staff will be supervising students in their faction bays (e.g. teacher in Eyre stay & assist in the Eyre tent).						
8:50 - 10:25	TRACK EVENTS: 50m & 75m (PP-YR6) 9:00AM: Pre Primary 50m race first. Once finished, Pre Primary students will go to basketball courts for their team game rotations (more info. below) Year 1-6 stay in their faction bays to watch track events. Collection Marshals will come to collect students for their races. Please have them lined up ready at the front of bays.						
10:25 - 10:45	RECESS Students are welcome to sit with their families during break times. Kindy Races - Will be on the track during eating time.						
10:45 - 12:45	FACTION TEAM GAMES / GROUP ROTATIONS After Recess, students will go back to their Faction tents. Teachers will line up students in their year levels in readiness for team game group rotations. A marshal will come to collect students and take them to their rotation. Year level teachers need to supervise their own year levels/faction and are responsible for supervising, assisting and scoring with group games. *Rotations are 20 minutes

No Colour Hair Spray - Writing on Body

We encourage all students to get into the spirit of the day and wear their faction colours. Coloured streamers/hair bows/bands, posters etc. are fine, however, students cannot colour their hair or write/draw on their bodies.



Sunscreen & Water

There will be sunscreen and water stations in each faction tent. Please regularly remind students to apply sunscreen and fill up their water bottles throughout the day.



Toilets

Students can access the nearest toilet when needed providing they have notified a staff member.



First Aid

First Aid will be located on the veranda of Block 5 near the bathrooms. Basic first aid and ice packs will be available. Students are responsible for their own asthma puffers; however, these are available if required. If there is a serious incident, please seek assistance from PE staff or admin who will be located on the track at both ends.



Sign Out

Any parents who wish to sign their child out before the end of the day will need to see the staff member at the First Aid table on the Block 5 veranda to complete a sign out slip.



Sportsmanship Award

At ESPS, we pride ourselves on being fair and displaying good sportsmanship in all activities. At the end of the carnival, one student from each year level (boy or girl) will be awarded the sportsmanship award. The student chosen will be selected and agreed upon by year level staff, so please keep a look out for students who cheer on their peers, try their best, help their team mates and are overall good faction members. Please consult before lunch and pass on the name to Phys Ed staff before the end of lunch. Make sure you have a backup person – in case the student is already going to win a champion trophy.
